Chuck Iley, Amador County CAO

An update on the impacts of the Governor's proposed budget changes

Amador County Administrative Officer (CAO) Chuck Iley joined the County as CAO in September 2010. As directed by the Amador County Board of Supervisors, Chuck's responsibilities include development and maintenance of the County budget, administrative coordination for all County departments and programs, staff support to the Board of Supervisors and management of specific programs.

Chuck most recently served as the Director of Development Services for Clay County, Florida, a community of 185,000 residents. As the department head, Mr. Iley was responsible for overseeing the engineering, planning, zoning, building and code enforcement divisions. His responsibilities included managing the operations of the Development Services department as well as the development of all Capital Improvement Plan projects, including three bond-funded road widening projects totaling approximately \$85 million.

Chuck graduated from the University of North Florida, where he attained a master's degree in business administration, as well as University of Miami, where he received a bachelor's degree in civil engineering. He is also a registered professional engineer in the state of California and once has previously worked for Caltrans, overseeing highway and bridge projects. Mr. Iley has family in the Volcano area and has moved his wife Molly and two children, Tricia and Emily, to Jackson.

23 individuals were interviewed by the Amador County Board of Supervisors before the field was narrowed down to five, then down to two. The Board made their final decision to hire Iley.

Chuck termed it "a great opportunity to speak with your Club, and I sincerely appreciate the invitation". Chuck, we appreciate your enthusiasm!
