**Dr. Martin L. Cody**  
Birds of Amador County



Martin Cody, Ph.D., is a Professor Emeritus at the Department of Ecology and Evolutionary Biology at UCLA. His research interests include community structure, determinants of diversity, density and distribution, inter-specific interactions and adaptive morphology. Dr. Cody has served as an expert on enumerable panels relating to birds and their habitat. His experience has been gathered from all around the globe.

Some of his publications include:

- Competition and the Structure of Bird Communities
- Plants on Islands: Diversity and Dynamics on a Continental Archipelago
- Habitat Selection in Birds
- Island Biogeography in the Sea of Cortes
- Resource Allocation Patterns in Palaearctic Warblers
- California Thrasher: Birds of North America Life Histories for the 21st Century
- Long -Term Studies of Vertebrate Communities

His research is concerned with questions that he regards as central in ecology:

What controls species' distributions and densities, and what are the determinants of the various components of species diversity? What are the factors that regulate community organization and structure, and what is the relative importance of biotic versus nonbiotic interactions in governing the limits of e.g. species' habitat ranges, foraging patterns,

morphological attributes and other niche parameters?

Martin, a resident of the Volcano area, is an expert ecologist who will tell us about birds in Amador County. This is a great program to bring a guest to.
