Welcome to Deaver Vineyards, where grape growing has been a family tradition for over 150 years. The Deaver Vineyard's 2007 Sierra Foothills Old Vine Zinfandel is one of those classic Zin's that the Deaver Family has been producing since the mid 1860's. This Zin has been afforded all of the accolades that it properly deserves. In January of 2010, this wine was judged at the San Francisco Chronicle's wine competition and was unanimously awarded "Double Gold."

A drive over Deaver's 300 acres will take you past 120-year-old Zinfandel vines and eight acres of Mission vines, so called because they were brought from Mexico by the Jesuits and Franciscans.
